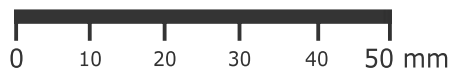
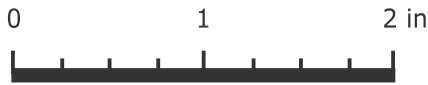


HOW TO FIND YOUR RING SIZE

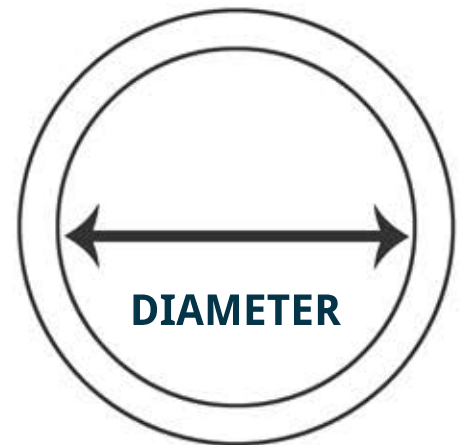
FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO MAINTAIN ACCURACY ON MEASUREMENTS



- 1** Before printing, be sure that Page Scaling option is set to none on your print dialog box.
- 2** Measure the bar on the left to ensure it is exactly 2 inches, or 50mm long.

MEASURE AN EXISTING RING

- Use a ring and put it on your ring finger. The finger between the pinky and middle finger. Engagement and wedding rings are usually worn on the left hand in the U.S.
- Put any ring of your choosing on top of one of the circles. The circle that is the closest to the inside edge of the ring is the good size



This measurement refers to the diameter of the ring.

- If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
